What is math fact fluency? Math fact fluency is the ability to recall the answer to math facts (0-10) automatically. (Ex: 8×3 ; 2×9)

How can I practice math facts? There are many games you can play to improve fact fluency (search “games to practice math facts.”) Flash cards are still a great way to practice math facts. The sites www.99math.com, www.xtramath.org and many apps are available for practice. Investing a few minutes each day will pay off in mastering basic math facts.
